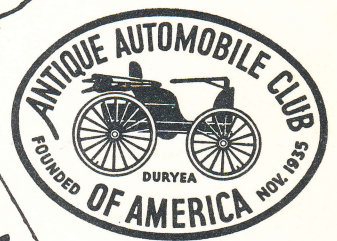

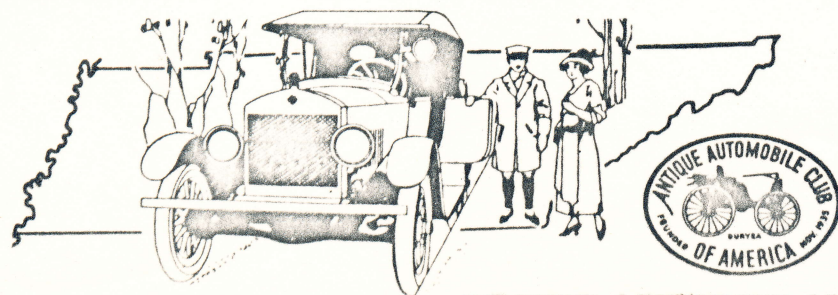

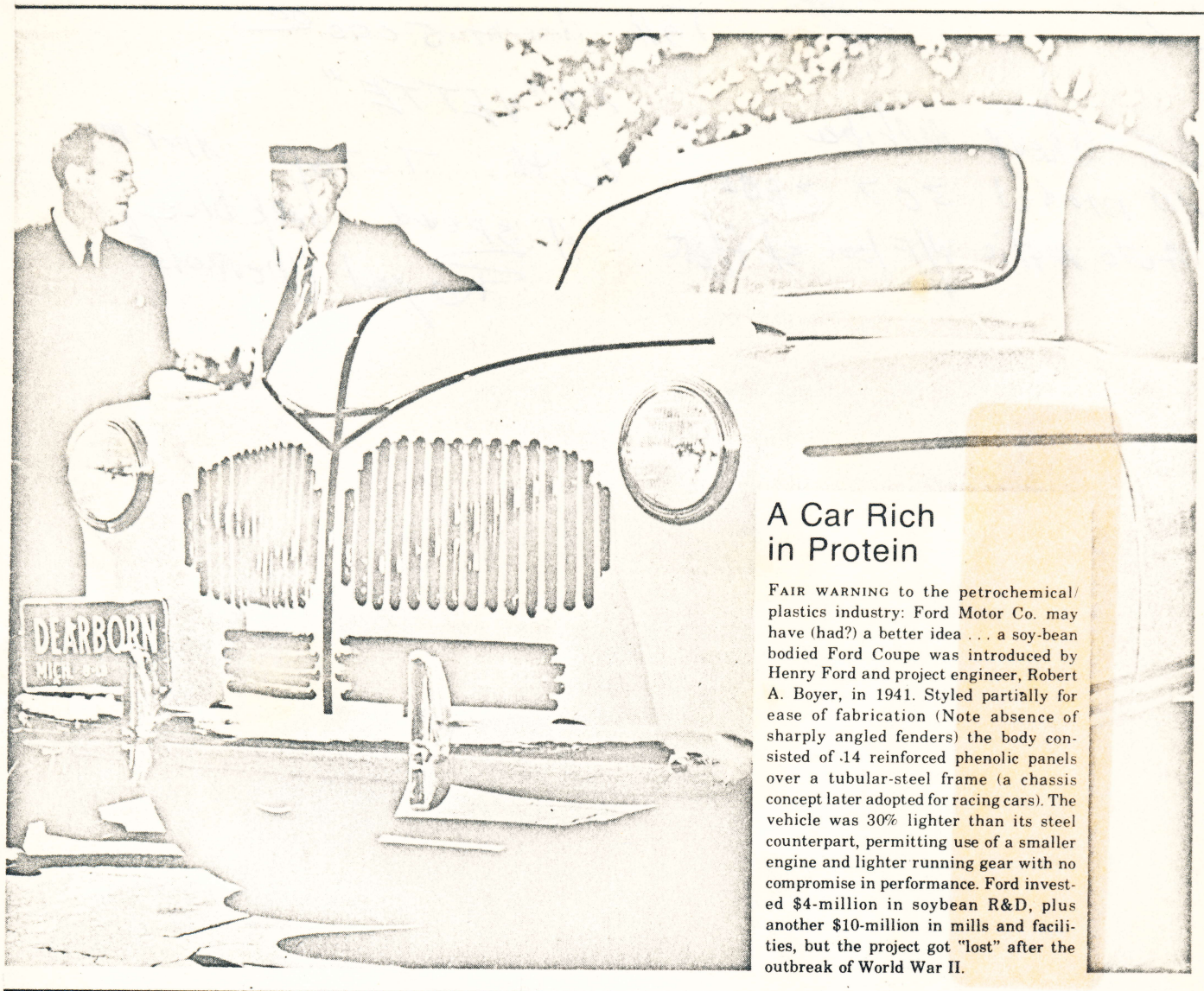

A Car Rich in Protein

FAIR WARNING to the petrochemical/plastics industry: Ford Motor Co. may have (had?) a better idea . . . a soy-bean bodied Ford Coupe was introduced by Henry Ford and project engineer, Robert A. Boyer, in 1941. Styled partially for ease of fabrication (Note absence of sharply angled fenders) the body consisted of 14 reinforced phenolic panels over a tubular-steel frame (a chassis concept later adopted for racing cars). The vehicle was 30% lighter than its steel counterpart, permitting use of a smaller engine and lighter running gear with no compromise in performance. Ford invested \$4-million in soybean R&D, plus another \$10-million in mills and facilities, but the project got "lost" after the outbreak of World War II.

12 lb./vehicle to more than 75 lb. Most of the increase came in the form of castings and as a substitute for copper in wiring. "Larger increases in aluminum will have to come from its use in large body panels, and our studies show that this would offer weight savings on the order of 40%," said Mr. Estes.

In the short term, GM indicates that it will concentrate on using aluminum in heavy optional items, including its large-

er engines. In this way, weight can be saved throughout entire car lines. "We should pursue applications involving castings rather than wrought aluminum for ease of recycling," Mr. Estes stated. He pointed out that iron and steel have enjoyed their favorable competitive positions in the auto industry because they are easily recycled. Approximately 35% of the nation's iron and steel production comes from recycled scrap, much of it

from junked cars.

A vital factor in the whole weight-reduction program scheduled by GM is the meshing of new vehicle designs and materials with existing manufacturing facilities. "We must design our new products for minimum tool and facilities expenditures, using existing facilities wherever possible. This is especially important in view of the industry's present financial problem," concluded Mr. Estes. —CEW
